## INFORMATION CLAUSE

In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016.(GDPR), as well as the relevant implementing acts, we inform that:

1. Your personal information is managed by the Toruń Symphony Orchestra based in Toruń at Aleja Solidarności 1-3, NIP 9561429917.

3. Personal data will be processed for the purpose of implementing the contract and/or taking action prior to its conclusion (Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR).
4. The recipients of your personal data shall be solely entities authorised to obtain personal data pursuant to the applicable law provisions and entities which are indirectly involved in contact with you (e.g. providing an IT service) and entities which process personal data on behalf of the controller on the basis of an entrustment contract for entrusting the processing of personal data.
5. With regard to the COVID-19 pandemic, we inform you that personal data may also be provided to GIS (Chief Sanitary Inspectorate) law enforcement services.
6. Personal data will be stored for the duration of the concluded contract, as well as after its termination, for the purpose of performing the obligations resulting from the legislation, statistics and archiving, as well as to pursue claims in connection with the performance of the contract.
7. You have the right to demand access to your personal data from the controller, the right to rectify, delete or restrict the processing of your data, to object to the processing of personal data.
8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
